Project Materials

- Medium Weight Chipboard, enough to make (2) pieces 4.25" x 5.5" ea. (recycled cardboard from paper pads works well too)
- (10) sheets 8.5" x 11" Paper, cut in half (sketch, drawing, or printer will work)
- ~65"-70" of 1mm Waxed Cotton/Linen Thread
- (10) small eyelets (optional) (*SpareParts*)
- ~12" Washi Tape (optional)

Utility Knife
Metal Ruler
Paper Trimmer (*Fiskars*)
Scoring Board + Bone Folder
Large Binder Clip
Needle Tool
T-Square
Pencil
Phonebook

Wood Board (as temp. support)

Possible Substitutions

Protect surface with old magazines or heavy cardboard
Exacto Knife, or purchase boards precut to size
Any metal straight edge
Optional (measure and line up straight edge to cut)

Large Pushpin, Small nail, or Small awl
Any Ruler
